Ingham Parish Council Update

This update is based on decisions made at the Annual meeting of the Parish Council on 9th May 2022 and actions since. You can find the most recent agreed minutes on the Parish Council website <https://ingham.parish.lincolnshire.gov.uk> and the Parish Council noticeboard.

Platinum Jubilee: We hope you were all able to enjoy the festivities of the jubilee weekend. It was great to see so many of you there. Thanks are extended to all those who assisted with the organisation of the events.

Recreation area project: We have received confirmation from West Lindsey District Council that the planning application for new equipment in the play area has been granted. We will now work with Kompan, the selected contractor, to arrange a suitable start date for the installation of new equipment. This is likely to be during July.

The speed indicator device records the speed of vehicles approaching and a report is received each month based on this data each month. During May/ June, the average speed on Church Hill was 35.3mph with some high speeds around 60 mph. The County Councillor is engaging with the Highways department to discuss any measures that may help to reduce the speeds here. Thank you to every driver who adheres to the speed limits around the village. You are helping to keep us all safe.

There has been another road traffic accident at the 'Crossways' junction (Lincoln Road/ Stow Lane) involving two vehicles. Thankfully no one was seriously injured. The County Council and Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership have been notified and a review is underway to try to improve the safety at this junction further.

Neighbourhood Plan: The steering committee met in June, including Openplan, to review the feedback received from the sites assessment public event. Openplan will analyse this further and this will be formalised at the next meeting in July. Meanwhile, the Parish Council will apply for a grant to assist with the costs related to the expected works in the forthcoming year.

Each year the Parish Council's Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR) needs to be reviewed by an external auditor appointed by Smaller Authorities' Audit Appointments Ltd. The unaudited AGAR has been published with this notice. As it has yet to be reviewed by the appointed auditor, it is subject to change as a result of that review. Any person interested has the right to inspect and make copies of the accounting records for the financial year to which the audit relates and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers, receipts and other documents relating to those records must be made available for inspection by any person interested. For the year ended 31 March 2022, these documents will be available on reasonable notice by application to the Clerk. The period in which this can be requested is between 13th June and 22nd July 2022.

May 2nd - 5th 2022



A Word from the Rural Dean

There is a spirit of movement about in the diocese at the moment. Bishop Stephen spoke to a cathedral full of newly elected churchwardens and hundreds of voices replied that they were ready to serve our churches and communities. Yours have a big job to do, defining how these eight churches are going to work together. Your representatives have met with the Covenant Pastors, and there was a great discussion about how your churches are going to contribute to the costs of ministry. Clergy and others from across the deanery have been coming to lead and share in worship with you, with remarkable few hiccups, and lots of good experiences on both sides. The Time to change Together process is going really well- every one of our 630 churches have prayerfully decided its vocation to serve local people and a wider kingdom; nearly every one of the clergy has had a conversation with the Bishops and Archdeacons about how they'd like to serve God in our churches and the new ways of working; over 50% of churches have pledged how much they believe God is calling them to put into the common pot and it is more than we dared hope; we've set up new partnerships between deaneries and are nearly ready to roll out Local Mission Partnerships- groups of churches and ministers that collaborate and work together – we will probably be about 25 churches.

So what is the best thing we can do together? What should Springline be doing? Here are a few thoughts. Getting your buildings in good shape to welcome visitors and all kinds of activities, and to present worship and offer fellowship and a sensational spiritual experience in the best possible way. Pray constantly. Share in your welcome, your gifting, your visiting, and your working together. The future is not *"this is the building and the handful of people I enjoy occasionally on a Sunday"* Those churches are not full of hope and they are not what Christ tells us in the Gospel. Seek fellowship with each other and seek to live close to God and seek. We aren't a heritage organisation and we aren't a social club, we are the church, the body of Christ, the Lord's eyes and ears, hands and feet and tongue. Our diocese is committed to supporting you with a wonderful array of ministry , some local, and some from further afield, some lay and some ordained, some pastoral and some prophetic, some comforting and some challenging. The New Creation we celebrated at Easter is a call to us all. With realistic and affordable resources we cannot rush about pretending each church is alive and well- we have to focus on those with a heart to do the Lord's work with joy, to share, to be bold, to be generous. Don't be amongst those "timorous mortals shivering on the brink", hanging onto the familiar for its own sake, barricading their faith in their buildings, staying put and not joining together, waiting gloomily for the death of the church rather than giving it new life. They will be gone in a few years-God is calling you to do so much more.

Scampton Church Community Partnership is awarded substantial grants by The National Lottery Heritage Fund & The FCC Communities Foundation to create the Scampton Community & RAF War Graves Heritage Centre.

Scampton Church has received a grant of £150,923 from The National Lottery Heritage Fund and an FCC Communities Foundation grant of £99,090, for an exciting heritage and community project to create the Scampton Community & RAF War Graves Heritage Centre in Scampton village. The project is costing £343,000 and is made possible by money raised by National Lottery players, the Landfill Communities Fund and also by public donations.

Working in partnership with RAF Scampton, The Commonwealth War Graves Commission (CWGC), local schools, Scampton Parish Council, Springline Good Neighbours Scheme and The Dambusters Inn, the project aims to create a vibrant and welcoming venue that will benefit the whole community. This includes local schools and other organisations which cater for the young and old in the area.

The grants will enable the installation of a new lit path, all access wc, welcome and refreshment area, and central heating.

In addition, visitors will be able to explore the rich history and heritage of both the 14th century church and its 107 Commonwealth war and service graves to 'keep their stories alive'. Digital consoles will be installed to help tell the stories of those who made the ultimate sacrifice, and to teach the next generation of the Commonwealth War Grave Commissions (CWGC) work. Furthermore, the CWGC hopes to use the church building as a regional hub, where free talks for the public can be given and exhibitions can be displayed. The facility will also provide the much needed space for the community's Good Neighbours Scheme to provide local services for the elderly. It is hoped that the project will be fully completed by the Spring of 2023 and will become a new community asset following the closure of RAF Scampton.

FRESH from ALISON'S KITCHEN

This is such a comforting meal that the whole family will love. Tender pieces of chicken, in a creamy sauce with the goodness of spinach and those rustic golden potatoes for the topping are just heavenly. Paired up with some green vegetables for the sides, this makes a delicious dig in and help yourself kind of meal.



Potato Topped Creamy Chicken and Spinach Pie

Ingredients

- 500g (17.5oz) of uncooked boneless skinless chicken thighs or breast, diced and all visible fat removed
- 800g (28oz) of Yukon golden potatoes (or similar variety of waxy/semi waxy potatoes)
- 1 onion, halved and sliced
- 2 cloves of garlic, crushed
- salt and black pepper
- 150g (5.5oz) of low fat cream cheese
- 350ml (1.5 cups) of whole milk
- 180ml (¾ cup) of chicken stock
- approx 6 cups/handfuls of fresh spinach
- 2 tablespoons of cornstarch
- cooking oil spray




Method

1. Preheat oven to 200c/400f (gas mark 6)
2. Place potatoes in a saucepan of water, bring to a boil and simmer till very slightly soft (not too soft that they are mushy) - approx 8-10 mins
3. Drain and rough up with a fork and set aside.
4. Spray a frying pan over a medium high heat with spray oil, add the chicken, season with salt and black pepper and cook until pieces are golden all over.
5. Remove and set aside, add the onion and garlic and a little of bit of the stock and fry until translucent.
6. Add in the cream cheese, milk and stock and whisk till smooth.
7. Mix the cornstarch with a little cold water to make a slurry, pour this into the sauce and allow to simmer until the sauce reduces and thickens from the cornstarch. (approx 10 minutes)
8. Add back in the chicken and stir in the spinach. It will seem a lot, but once you start stirring it in, it wilts down to hardly anything.
9. Add the chicken and sauce to a an ovenproof dish. Top with the rustic potatoes. Season over top with salt and black pepper.
10. Spray over the top with spray oil, and place in the oven and bake until the potatoes are a lovely golden colour (approx 40 mins)
11. Serve with your choice of vegetables.
